Project Progress: Launching the Development of AGROS Courses



This deliverable (IO1) is the core output of the project, and it constitutes the specific output upon which there will be built the whole training activity. The course will support citizens and local communities' members in general by transmitting the right knowledge and inspiration to adopt green roofs to the level it is desirable to them. In this approach, learners will be empowered with their environmental awareness and responses, and they prove to be

active members in addressing EU environmental problems.

The development of the course will be structured into two main parts: learning contents and digital context. Learning contents will include key green roofs related training modules while digital context will propose online platform for virtual learning environment.

At the moment, partners lead by Kaunas STP (Lithuania) are finalizing the Methodology of the Development of AGROS courses which defines the specifics of project target audience, key principles of adult education; introduces to the course curriculum by identifying curriculum structure, main parts of each module of the course and the steps for curriculum development; innovativeness of the AGROS course and its transferability potential.

This introduction to the development of the project's courses allows partners to be aware of what, how, for whom they are dedicating their time and to work step by step towards the project's main objectives. The full set of learning modules for the AGROS course will be presented shortly.
