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**Case study: Riverfront Park, Nashville, Tennessee**

Riverfront Park, which opened in July 2015, incorporates green infrastructure measures for flood control, including a bioswale, bioretention areas, and rainwater harvesting. Landscape architecture firm Hawkins Partners led an interdisciplinary team to create a design that includes 4,000 square feet of green roof and 12,500 square feet of permeable pavers
