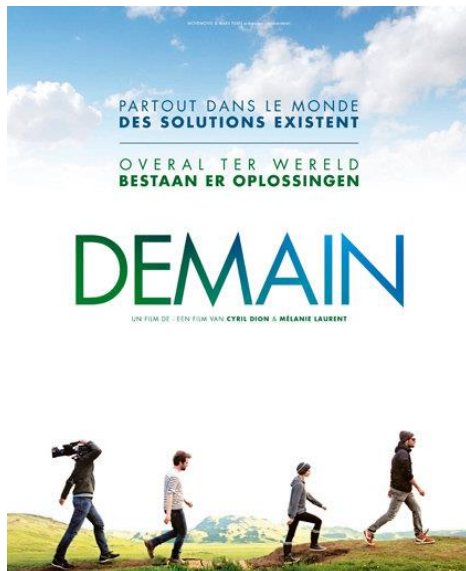


### 3. A FILM TO SEE: “DEMAIN”



In 2012, two researchers from Stanford and Berkeley Universities published a study that for the first time raised the possibility that our species could become extinct largely due to human activity.

The film "TOMORROW" aims to highlight alternatives, people who are mobilizing and proposing innovative solutions for the future and who encourage people to change their behavior in a true eco-citizen conscience.

The two directors and their teams traveled to 10 countries around the world to meet "women and men who are committed to building a new ecological, economic and social model, synonymous with hope for future generations.

The film was divided into 5 themes:

- Urban agriculture and permaculture
- Renewable energies and energy transition
- Economy and local or complementary currencies
- Direct democracy and citizen engagement
- Education and learning to live together

"The documentary highlights concrete initiatives carried out by different types of actors, whether entrepreneurs or ordinary citizens, which respond directly to these ecological and social emergencies. Yet these initiatives only need to be experimented on a larger scale."
