The European Union (EU) is supporting the utilisation of nature-based solutions to help cities become more sustainable. However, green spaces in urban areas are often unequally distributed, with parks, tree-lined streets and green roofs planned for wealthy and gentrifying districts. Those living in poor districts lack these spaces, and their introduction is not a priority for urban planners – nor necessarily a demand from the inhabitants, especially when basic infrastructure might be lacking.
