Latvia

Brief Piloting Testing Report

The Piloting of the project AGROS in Latvia was organised by the Latvian Association of Local and Regional Governments. The piloting procedure was in accordance with the Piloting Guide.

AGROS course modules were translated in Latvian, and participants have completed at least one AGROS course module in their national language. The participants got acquainted with the project, its main concepts and principles, and objectives. The evaluation form was translated in Latvian, thus the AGROS Courses were piloted by a wide range of people and reached various target groups. Each participant was asked to choose the Module that was more relevant with their background, experience, or interests, study all the available material and complete the online quiz. The comments in the evaluation questionnaire were generally very positive, with most participants indicating that they were interested in the AGROS project courses. It stimulated many participants' interests in learning more about green roofs and promoting environmental awareness.



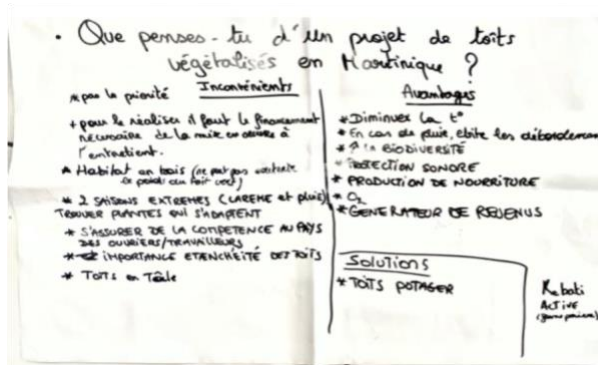
Lithuania

Brief Piloting Testing Report

The piloting activities of the "Agros Course" took place between October 2022 and January 2023 and has been organized by Kaunas Science and Technology Park (Kaunas STP).

Kaunas STP have reached the number of 50 registered participants on the AGROS courses. 50 people registered to the MOOC platform, took at least one module, and filled out the evaluation questionnaire. As it has been suggested by the Piloting Guide the recruitment process of the pilot was addressed at such target groups: local communities' citizens, NGOs and CSOs members, relative associations members and representatives; public local authorities, leaders/representatives, public servants; professionals, experts, environmentalists, agriculturalists, urban architects, gardeners, technologists, engineers, etc., labour and entrepreneurship associations; adult and lifelong training institutions, centres and providers; institutions educators; academia, scientists. According to this, in fact, the course attracted representatives of public authorities, lifelong learning training institutions, topic related private companies, NGO's, urban architects, a number of academics, citizens. All participants were satisfied with a learning content and evaluated as very good. Almost all participants say that they would recommend the course for others. Let's hope that they will do so and will spread the word about our work done further on!

Multiplier Event in France



The Multiplier Event of the project AGROS took place in Fort De France, Martinique, on Saturday 26 November 2022, organised by D'Antilles et D'Ailleurs.

The aim of the event was to inform local community and participants about the project, encourage them to share and exchange experiences and ideas and especially feedback on the potentialities of GreenRoofs' design in the island and more on the programme.

In total, 23 people signed but more participated, coming from various organizations, NGOs oriented towards environmental protection and sustainable development: L'ASSO-MER, Zéro déchet Martinique, Zéro déchet sauvage, one member of GreenPeace. As well as one environmental quality building engineer and nature lovers and amateur gardeners since the Multiplier event was organized within the final and closing event of the project "Zéro Plastique an Loséan" (ZEPAL) 2022 (Zero plastic in the Ocean) set up by the NGO "L'ASSO-MER".

During the meeting participants have been participants have been invited to share and discuss guided by a simple question: what do you think about a project focused on Green Roofs in Martinique?

Multiplier Event in Greece



On the 16th of January 2023, the team of XENIOS POLIS conducted a face-to-face workshop entitled "Sustainable Development", which took place in the "Harokopio University of Athens- School of Environment, Geography and Applied Economics", supporting by the department of "Economics & Sustainable Development" as well as the "SDG Student Hub" of the Harokopio University. The event was attended by professors, students and other stakeholders, who were informed about the project and shared valuable experiences and ideas for its sustainability. More specifically, 66 people attended the event, 8 professors and PhD candidates at the University in the field of sustainable development, 45 students and 13 other stakeholders, coming from various organizations and backgrounds, such as NGOs oriented towards environmental protection and sustainable development.

The aim of the event was:

- to inform the participants about the project, its objectives and its outcomes that were derived from the Intellectual Outputs' development,
- to inform them about relative to the environmental sustainability issues such as the environmental degradation, the sustainable urban resilience, the connection between the environment and the digital literacy.
- to encourage the participants to share and exchange experiences and ideas.

Final Conference in the Municipality of Palma de Condado in Spain



The final conference for the AGROS project took place on the 13th of February in the City Hall of the Palma de Condado, in Spain.
